The aim of the Camp is to promote international understanding among young people of different cultures and to encourage young people to contribute to the restoration of human rights all over the world.

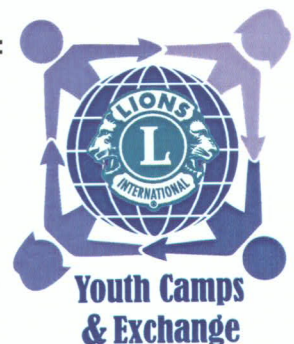
A full and varied programme has been designed, which will include sightseeing tours to historical monuments of the Island, swimming, entertainment, presentation of participants home countries and discussions on human rights. The programme will offer to the participants the opportunity to exchange ideas with other young people, make new friends and enjoy the natural beauties of the Island of Cyprus.

Participants must be fluent in English language and must be sponsored by a Lions Club in their own country. The sponsoring Club will be responsible for arranging flights to Larnaca International Airport, Cyprus, and vice-versa and insurance against accidents, risk of travel, serious illness, loss of luggage through accident, theft or burglary, plus liability for third party risks. The sponsoring Club must also ensure that the participants have adequate spending money for the whole duration of their stay (minimum EURO 300).

Accommodation in the camp, transfers, meals and other activities during the Camp will be covered with camp fees €250 for each participant. We do not offer any family hosting before or after the Camp, therefore, earliest arrival date is 07/07/2020 and latest departure date is 21/07/2020.
